



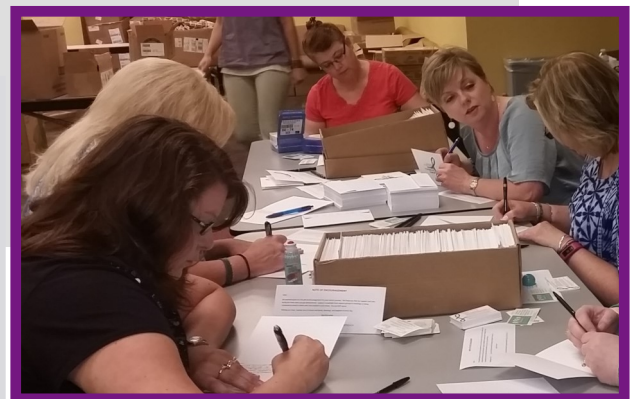
# Corporate Service Opportunities

# Employee Engagement Opportunities

The Laura Crandall Brown Foundation staff will work with your company to develop a service project that facilitates team building and helps meet your goals as well as serves the needs of our organization. A typical service day is as follows:

## **Number of Volunteers**

8 to 20 employees

## **Service Project: Volunteer to Assemble Patient Comfort Care Bags**

This activity includes sorting and arranging items, assembling and boxing the completed bags, and writing notes of encouragement for patients that will be included in the bags assembled that day. In addition, volunteers are asked to help inventory and box remaining items for future bag assemblies.

## **Tentative Service Day Schedule:**

11:00 am	Arrive at predetermined location (Can be on site at company)
11-11:30 am	Lunch & Learn — overview of LCBF and services (Bring your own lunch or company can provide.)
11:30 am - Noon	Sort and arrange items for bags
12:00 - 1:00 pm	Assemble pre-determined # of Comfort Care bags
1:00 - 1:30 pm	If applicable, inventory and pack remaining items.

## **Mutual Benefit:**

Without our corporate partners' time, commitment and contributions, the Laura Crandall Brown Foundation would not be able to serve our community in this capacity. Together we can work toward- our mission of reaching every patient in Alabama. Our hope is this experience helps with teaming building within your organization and helps your employees feel a personal connection to the cancer patient's journey. **If possible, we ask that you schedule your service day at least two months in advance. As an additional contribution, we encourage your employees to host an item drive prior to assembly day.**

## **Host an item collection drive for our patient bags:**

The foundation assembles a total of 800 bags per year and we try to get most of the items donated. We always need supplies, and are grateful for any amount you can collect and donate. Let us know which of the items your company would like to collect: Ex: individual hand sanitizer, emery boards, chap stick, pill boxes, travel lotion, travel Kleenex, colored pencils, hard candy, soft/fuzzy socks, head coverings, etc.

**Note:** Other one-time volunteer opportunities are available for LCBF special events, including Taste of Teal Gala (March), Head Over Teal 5K/10K/Fall Festival (September), Get Busy Fighting Golf Tournament (November). Feel free to inquire about any of these events if you have employees who may like to volunteer.
